Beloved vocalist Greg Lake will perform at the Keswick Theatre on April 19th

As the lead vocalist on King Crimson's In the Court of the Crimson King and In the Wake of Poseidon, Greg Lake (http://www.greglake.com /index.html) arguably sang with the first progressive rock band, and with Emerson, Lake, and Palmer, he fronted one of the most successful groups the genre has ever had. Currently, he is embarking on a solo tour entitled "Songs of a Lifetime: An Intimate Evening with Greg Lake," and on Thursday, April 19th, he'll perform at the Keswick Theatre. With such a distinctive voice, personality, and catalogue, it's sure to be a fantastic show.

Following ELP's final album (1978's Love Beach), Lake released his eponymous debut solo album in 1981 and its follow-up, Manoeuvres, in 1983. Since then, he's released several albums with Keith Emerson and Cozy Powell, as well as many lives albums with various projects. In terms of the setlist at the Keswick Theatre performance, nothing is confirmed, but fans can expect to see a highly enjoyable mixture of solo material and songs he's done with bands (as well as some interesting and humorous conversation, no doubt).
