Schmidt was also one of 25 chefs from across America to have a dish featured at the 2012 James Beard 25th anniversary gala reception.

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His dish, Roman and Jerusalem Artichoke with Pasilla Vinaigrette, was served to a group of 200 foundation board members and guests at a VIP four-course tasting menu.

Schmidt won the prestigious James Beard Award for "best Chef Midwest" in 1993 for his work at Rattlesnake Club in Detroit. Sous chef Brian Recor from Morgan's in the desert, restaurant general manager John Healy, and Schmidt's wife Jo Marie accompanied Schmidt at the Beard Foundation event.

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
